

## Ethics assessment application form 2017/2018

Guidance - please read this first

Ethics is an important part of a financial accountant's professional development.

The IFA requires its students and members to complete an ethics assessment to progress to Associate membership or provide evidence of equivalent qualification or training .

Before completing the assessment the IFA requires you to undertake some ethics learning. You can pursue ethics learning by studying the IFA's online study material text and doing further research and reading.

If you have already done some ethics learning and can provide evidence, this will also be acceptable.

## How the eAssessment works

- 1. Complete this form
- 2. Confirm whether you have undertaken any previous ethics learning and provide evidence..
- 3. The IFA will send you the assessment via email.
- 4. You will have eight weeks from the date the eAssessment is sent to you to complete it.
- 5. You must complete your assessment as a Microsoft Word file.
- 6. Please remember you have agreed to abide by the IFA's regulations when you registered as a student of the IFA. As such in completing the assessment:
  - Do not copy, plagiarise or otherwise use others work.
  - Your answers must be authentic and original, produced by you.
  - If you want to use a quote or refer to some published material you should fully reference it to its source. Plagiarising material could lead to your being referred to the IFA disciplinary process or your exclusion from the IFA.
  - If you contravene any of these rules you will be considered to be in breach of the IFA's Code of Ethics.
  - You must not share or pass the assessment material or your answers to anyone else.
- 7. You should expect to hear within 4 weeks of submission that the outcome of our assessment is.
- 8. You will either pass the assessment or receive feedback which means you would need to resubmit (ie you failed the assessment).
- 9. For successful students the IFA issues a transcript result: certificates are not provided.
